**Jano Graphics Adds New Heidelberg Speedmaster XL 75 Press**

**Ventura, CA 6/01/09** - Jano Graphics is pleased to announce it has installed the very latest in printing technology, the Heidelberg Speedmaster XL 75 printing press. The new 24 x 29 five color press is the latest addition to the peak performance class from Heidelberg and is equipped with the new Prinect Press Center, which combines press operation with color and register control in a single, central console.

The XL 75 press runs at speeds up to 18,000 sheets per hour. Inking settings are quick and reliable with Prinect technology, and quality can be controlled and kept consistent during the entire run. With Prinect's integrated color workflow, printing is based on well-defined, standardized values that can be reliably controlled with measuring equipment. At the prepress stage, parameters can be established to automatically preset the press, thereby turning pre-press and the pressroom into a single system.

The XL 75 also boasts a larger sheet format compared to other presses in the mid-size category. "We are excited to be the first printing company on the west coast with a press of this kind," said Joseph Jannone, Pressroom Manager. The efficient sheet size reduces paper waste and reduces the number of set ups, both considerable factors in helping to reduce costs.

The XL 75 was also chosen for its "green" appeal. As a Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) certified printer, Jano Graphics takes environmental matters seriously. The most important environmental factor in sheet-fed offset printing is start up waste. The average is 600 sheets per job. With the XL 75's new Prinect technology, paper spoilage can be reduced by up to 50 percent. That translates into 190 tons of paper saved a year. That's about 3,000 trees. The XL 75 is also optimized for low carbon emissions. With the help of innovative control systems, the press adjusts its energy consumption to the respective demand. At the end of the day, this means it needs less energy per sheet than most competitor products. It also utilizes components free of alcohol, toxins and other volatile organic compounds (VOCs).

The new XL 75 is a key addition to Jano Graphics' pressroom, complementing its four other smaller to larger sized Heidelberg presses ranging from 18" to 40" presses.
